TMAM-050075-0417-15 is an active X4 frequency multiplier. The multiplier has an input frequency of 12.5 to 18.75 GHz with a typical input power of +5 dBm and an output frequency of 50 to 75 GHz with a typical output power of +17 dBm. The DC power requirement for the multiplier is +12 V DC/135 mA. The input port configuration is a female SMA connector and the output is a WR-15 waveguide with a UG-385/U-M anti-cocking flange.

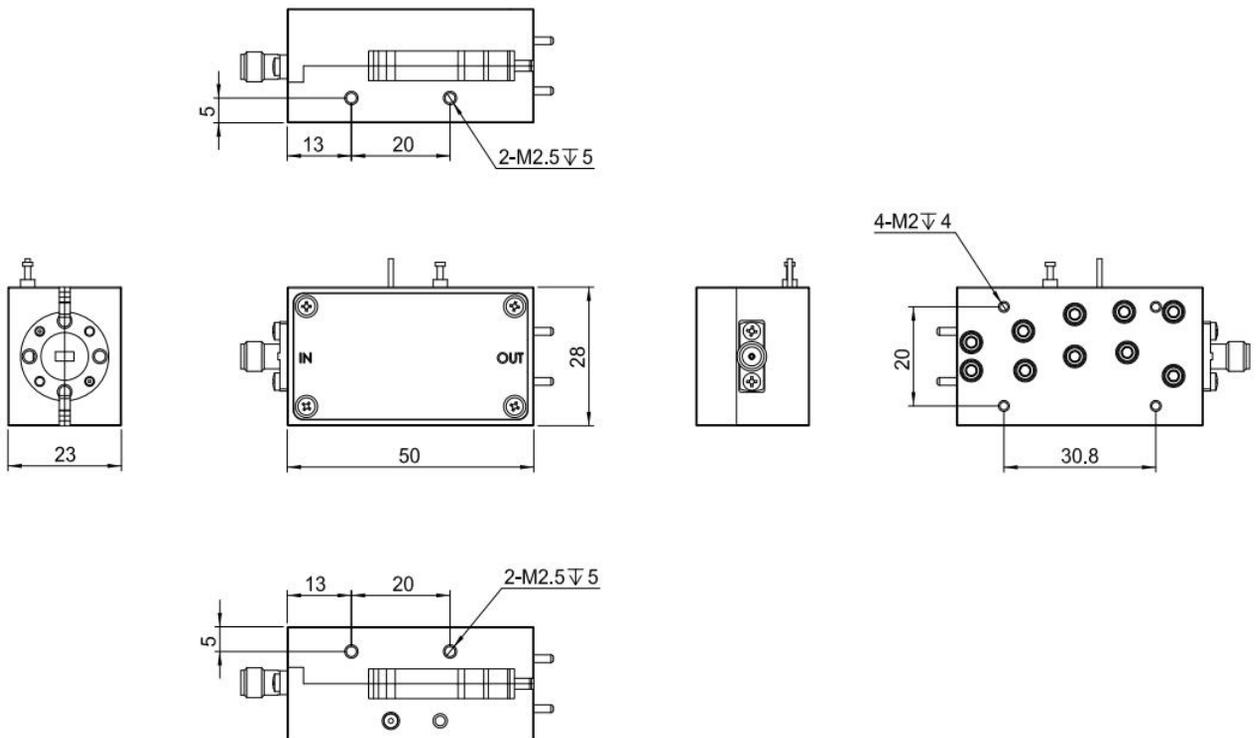

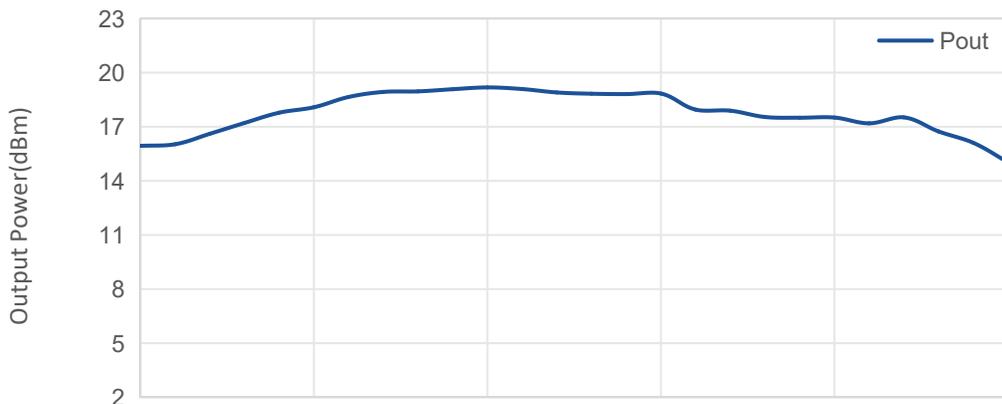

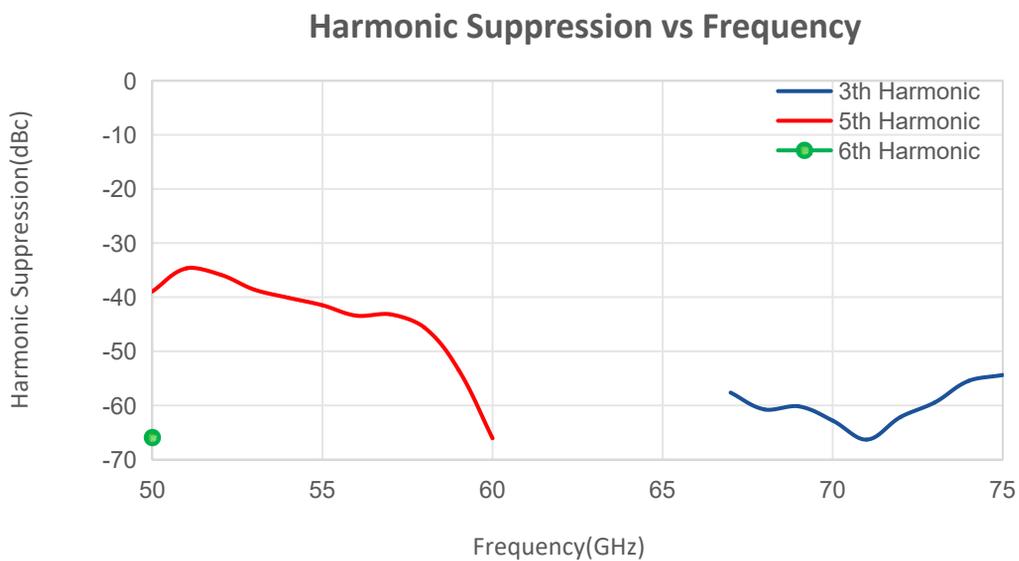
